

Town of Green Lake
Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, April 13, 2026

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Supervisor Strelow arrived at 7:12 All board members were present. There was 1 citizen in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Moderow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Moderow, seconded by Berndt to approve the minutes of the regular monthly meeting on March 9, 2026. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – the board members reviewed January report. There were \$5,379.80 in credits and \$48,881.75 debits. Reported balances on Money Market, CD and Phelps Savings Account. Motion to approve Treasurer's report and the transfer of \$30,000 to the general for the payment of bills. Motion made by Berndt, seconded by Moderow. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – Dan reported they did road checks with Fahnners and Scott to get bids for road sealing. We're getting an estimate from the county for crack filling Prairie, South of Miller Road to Hwy 44, North Kearly from Kearly to Eric Road, and McAfee from Kahl to Blackbird Point. Oakwood Beach Road has been swept along with Circle Drive and Kahl Road. They plan to go back with a blower shortly to do driveway entrances. Branches have been trimmed on Lakeview and Tuleta Hill Road. They still need to go around and pick up larger limbs when the ground firms up. Weight limit signs have been removed. The cemeteries and Town Hall lawns have been treated by TruGreen. The county has not sprayed the ditches yet as the weather hasn't cooperated. The piers on Little Green Lake have been placed as well as the pier at Horners. Thursday, April 11 a gas leak was detected by the shop gas meter. It has been repaired at no cost to the town. Gas was turned back on Friday afternoon. The Town Hall was not affected.

Approval Mobile Home Park Licenses – Approval for Shady Oaks and South Shore Terrace annual mobile home licenses. The motion was made by Moderow/Strelow to approve. Motion carried.

2026 Roads – Chairman Moderow announced that the town will be receiving \$470,000 in grant funds for 2.5 miles of Prairie Road. We received two bills for chip sealing. One from Fahrner and one from Scotts. Fahrner was McAfee Road – Kahl Road to Blackbird Point was \$5730, Boelter Road – Hwy B to End was \$5,600, Utley Road to Tichora Road to Hwy 44 was \$28,300, Fiegel Road to Utley Road to End was \$14,283. Fiegel Road Options double chip seal \$24,281 or single chip seal with 1020' bar seal was \$19,497. ¼ Aggregate Roadways Black Granite Oakwood Avenue – Tuleta Hill Road to End was \$30,311. Post Roadway Sweeping (if necessary) \$175 per hour. Scotts bid was as follows: McAfee Road to Kahl Road to Blackbird Point Rd was \$6,511, Boelter Road to CTH B to Termini was \$6,577, N Kearly Road to Eric Rd to Kearly Rd was \$21,065, Utley Road to STH 44 to Tichora Rd was \$28,964, Fiegel Rd to Utley Rd to Town line was \$11,300, Double seal option total as \$20,910. Thomas Rd to Prairie Road to County Line Rd was \$27,181. Discussion was had – will make decision at next month's meeting.

Town Hall Updates – Chairman Moderow talked with General Engineering, and they plan to stop out later next week to look over the ideas for some updates on the town hall.
