

Town of Green Lake - Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, August 10, 2026

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present. There were 2 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the minutes of the regular monthly meeting on July 13, 2026. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Strelow, seconded by Berndt to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – the board members reviewed the report. There were \$ 71,678.14 credits and \$ 65,460.36 debits. Reported balances on Money Market, CD and Phelps Savings Account. Motion to approve Treasurer's report with the transfer needed for the equipment fund for the insurance deposit we received. Motion made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – The brush has been cleaned up at the end of Oakwood Road, and the "No Parking" signs have been removed. Glen Wood Beach guard belt area has been cleaned up of a brush and weeds. The trees on the East Little Green landings have been trimmed by the road for better vision and the buckthorn sprayed. Eric ____ and Horner's needed tree clean up after a storm went through. All the chip seal and paving projects roads have been mowed. There is one driveway for Kasuboski field that should be widened for semis to protect the edge of the road on both sides. I have not heard of a start date from Koplin & Kinas on the culvert extension yet. I sprayed brush in the heavy buckthorn areas. The spraying of the county did help tremendously. Austin and Carter went around and ground most all of the stumps and cleaned up the chips. The capacitor went bad on the AC and Superheat replaced it. I've shown cemetery plots at Center Cemetery but have not sold any yet. Looking at getting the camper removed from Tuleta Hill Road.

Green Lake County Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use Map – Chairman Moderow made a motion to accept the future land use map submitted by Green Lake County. Seconded by Berndt. Motion carried.

Parking Enforcement Ordinance – Chairman Moderow contact the WTA about appointing a constable for issuing parking tickets. Chairman Moderow read the email he received from the WTA. At our next meeting we will discuss an ordinance to help get more enforcement at the landings.

Online Tax Payments – Treasurer Machkovich discussed the process of the online credit card payments. Due to the recent payment getting NSF after settlement was completed by the town. Machkovich suggested that the town close credit card payment on January 31st. Chairman Moderow made a motion to close credit card payment on January 31, seconded by Berndt. Motion carried.

Closed Session – Employment Review –

Motion was made by Strelow/Berndt/ Strelow to go into Closed Session. Motion carried. Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to go back into Open Session.
