Regular Board Meeting Minutes
August 8, 2022

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present. We also had 1 citizen attend this meeting.

Motion was made by Berndt/Moderow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Moderow/Zick to approve the minutes from the July 11, 2022. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – We received \$23,923.58 in July 2022 Credits and \$41,438.89 in Debits. We need a transfer for the Phelps account in the amount of \$8,337.28 – for expenses/new lawn mower. We will be getting our August settlement in the next week. Motion by Berndt/Moderow to approve the transfer for Phelps and will be going out prior to August 21st.

Maintenance Report – Dan reported that the new mower works really well. He has cut some trees at the landing on the Eastside of Little Green and Horners. No Parking signs will be going up after Diggers Hotlines marks it up on Friday. Also putting up the new signs by the landing for the \$5.00 fee. Also need to draft up an application for an annual fee of \$30.00 for a boating landing fee – which will go out with the tax bills in December. Discussion was had about Luedtke Road with the culvert issues, end walls need more gravel. Chairman Moderow will be talking with Egbert about the issue. Ditch mower will be here in April 2023.

Strelow Land – Sondalle Law office is working with the Strelow's with the land donation.

Park & Boat Landing Ordinance – After viewing the ordinance a motion was made by Zick/Berndt. Motion carried.

Phelps Cemetery – Chairman Moderow wrote a letter to Judge Slate about the Alice Phelps trust. Everything is taking care of with the courts. May open it up to use funds for all the cemeteries.

Temporary Liquor License – Motion made by Berndt/Moderow to approve the temporary liquor license for Avrom Farms for the event on August 12-14, 2022. Motion carried.

Audience Participation – 3 Minute Limit – Wally Szkwarko-W1324 Spring Grove Road – came to talk about the issues with rental properties/AirBNB and the noise issues.
