

Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, February 1, 2021

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and in three public places in the Town.

Chairman Moderow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Ben Moderow, Tom Zick, Katie Mehn, Lindsey Machkovich, Dominic Machkovich, Jim Clark, and Craig Muenchow. Dan Berndt was absent.

Motion was made by Zick/Moderow to approve the agenda. Motion carried

Motion was made by Moderow/Zick to approve the minutes from the January 4, 2021 regular monthly meeting and the January 9, 2021 Caucus meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Treasurer Machkovich reported that the County has deposited \$1,684,881.72 for January Tax Collection. The tax account has been closed, the balance was transferred to the MM- Tax Account. Dog licenses are coming in as well. Machkovich will also look into the Capital Account.

Maintenance Report: They are working on plowing most of the time. They did some brushing cutting in the beginning of the month. In the spring, they plan to clean up near Miller Road, may need to check with the phone company first for wires.

Old Business

2021 Roads- Chairman Moderow, Dominic and Chris still need to get together and check out the town's roads. Will discuss at next month's meeting.

Landing fee on Little Green Lake – Jim Clark the Chairman for LGLPR discussed the possibility of changing the landing fees to mandatory and raise to \$5.00. After discussion, the town agreed to get better signage and raise the donation to \$5.00.

Little Green Lake Boat Landing fee – Treasurer Machkovich reported that \$1,294.69 would be 50% of the landing fees collected last year. Motion made by Moderow/Zick. Motion carried. Clerk Mehn will mail a check to LGLPR.

New Business

Scharschmidt Rezone – after reviewing the paperwork from Land Use & Zoning a motion was made by Moderow/Zick to approve the rezone. Motion carried. Clerk Mehn will forward the signed paperwork onto Matt Kirkman at Land Use & Zoning.

Operating License- Amy Muenchow – Craig Muenchow spoke on behalf of the issues with their business. Motion made to accept the operating license by Moderow/Zick. Motion carried. NOTE: We will need a copy of a deed and/or lease agreement in order to issue the next liquor license in June 30,2021.
