February 14, 2022

2022 Roads – Road to be looked at for 2022. Possible crack filling roads as follows: Oakwood Avenue, Oakwood Beach Road, Kahl Road, N. Kearley Road. Possible chip sealing roads: Center Road, Lakeview, North Kearley Road, O to Boat Landing. Get a price on Sandstone-might need to hire an engineer for that road design. We will run an ad for bids and discuss them at the April 2022 Town Board meeting.

Little Green Land Donation – Chairman Moderow spoke with the DNR. There are two grants we can apply for and cover 100% of the project. The town can apply by the end of this year and could get the funds in the 2023 year. The landowners are okay with waiting. The town will go ahead and apply for the grant. Moderow will talk with Matt Kirkman at the County what the first steps will be. Motion to go ahead and start the process of the land donation to parking lot...made by Berndt/Zick. Motion carried.

Ditch Mower – Dominic received a few quotes for a ditch mower. After discussion a motion was made by Moderow/Zick to accept the price of the Ed Priebe for the ditch mover and get it ordered.

ARPA Grant – There has been more flexible spending on these funds. The board will discuss how they would like to use these at a later meeting.
