

Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, January 4, 2021

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and in three public places in the Town.

Chairman Moderow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the agenda. Motion carried

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the minutes from the December 7, 2020 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Treasurer Machkovich reported that the County is depositing tax money into our account on a daily/weekly basis. Next meeting she will have a total of what the amount is. She will be added building permits (monthly and YTD), Fire Dept and Equipment Fund to her report. Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to close the Tax Account \$1,729.32 and the balance would go into the Money Market to the tax sub account. Motion carried

He will be looking into getting the old culverts removed. Issue with citizen complaining about snow by her driveway when the town plows. She maybe attending a meeting in the future.

Clerk Initiation: Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to appoint Katie Mehn as Town Clerk and Lindsey Machkovich as Town Treasurer effective as January 4, 2021 Jennifer will be helping Katie as a as needed basis and acting as Deputy Clerk. Chairman Moderow will still bring in the job descriptions to have on file.

New Business

2021 Roads – after discussion Chairman Moderow, Dominic and Chris Stollfuss will be riding around the town to check out the roads. Moderow will report back next month on their findings. No action taken.

Landing Fees – after discussion Zick will report to Little Green Lake District that the town is okay with them raising the donation to \$5.00 but would not want the landing fees to be mandatory. No way to enforce it. Berndt suggested to have better signage for donations. Also Treasurer Machkovich will be charging for milage and fees until August and then after August no more milage because Dominic is picking up the landings fee. No motion was made.
