

## Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, March 1, 2021

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall, Center House, Walkers, and the town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present.

Motion was made by Zick/Berndt to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the minutes from the February 1, 2021 regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Zick/Berndt to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer Machkovich reported the credits we received in January. Also, she reported that we will need to transfer \$249,820.31 from general checking to Money Market, Tax account for February of that \$164,820.31 to the MM Tax Account, \$10,000.00 to Contingencies Account, \$75,000 to Capital Account of that \$25,000 for Fire Equipment and \$50,000 for the Town Equipment. She received a check for Mobile Home permit fee that was NSF, and the Town was charged a fee from the bank. Starting this year, we would like to charge a \$30.00 charge for any NSF checks. A motion to accept the treasurer's report, bank transfer and the NSF fee was made by Berndt/Zick. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – A lot of plowing for the month. Started burning the brush pile. They will be posting roads this week either Wednesday or Thursday. There have been some issues with the pick-up truck lately, might need to be looked at in the future. The mower is also something we need to think about in the next year or two.

### Old Business

2021 Roads: Ben, Dominic, and Chris went and looked at the roads last week. After discussion, Clerk Mehn will be putting an ad in the newspaper for two weeks for the 2021 Road Project Bids. Will discuss at future meetings after we receive bids.

### New Business

Countywide Ambulance-the board is not in favor of the countywide ambulance service or giving up their assets.

BOR and Open Book dates: BOR Thursday, June 10, 2021 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Open Book is schedule for Monday, May 17, 2021 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Open book will be handled the same as last year where they will be held via phone or email only.
