March 14, 2022

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Machkovich has collected the Mobile Home Taxes this month. A lot of building permits, fire inspections and calls. Total credits were \$609,931.97 and total debits were \$3,097,069.97 for the month. Tax collections is over and there will be another settlement in August. Dog licenses are due by March 31. Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to approve the treasurer report. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – probably the most he has plowed all season. The roads are posted now. Fire numbers will be put up. Salt shed is full now, needs to investigate who does salt shed inspection. Also met with Lucas the road engineer to discuss some possible road designs.

Budget adjustment for Grand River Fire District Truck Purchase – Approval to show that we moved \$80,094 into the Cash Reserve Fund on the Income side to fund the Fire Truck for the Grand River Fire District. Motion made by Moderow/Berndt. Motion carried.

Mary Zick – spoke about an erosion problem with a gully on the Town’s property where a lot of debris is going into the lake. The county and sanitary district is aware of the situation and will be working on fixing it.
