Treasurer Machkovich reported a lot of transactions happened this month. The Transportation aid came in from the state. Our lottery credit came in from the county, we will be getting another payment in mid-September. We had our first Phelps transaction for the year. No money transferred needed this month. Maintenance Report – Stumps are all out by Miller Road. Signs at the landings are up. Will contact someone about the boat washing station signs that are still out there. All the winter stuff is done and put away. The new truck has the equipment on it. Started mowing and getting landing fees now. Town will pay Dominic \$300.00 a day to take the stumps out. He worked on it for two days. Dan had a question about who is running the cable, Dominic will investigate it.

Old Business

2021 Roads: Scotts Construction will be doing the seal coating. The town will be seal coating Horner Landing's, Spring Grove Road, Melmar, and Welk Road. Kartechner Brothers will be doing the reconstruction project. The roads the town will be doing are Center Road from County N to County Road A, Lakeshore Drive and Little Green Road. Approval Operator License - Motion made by Berndt/Moderow Motion carried.

Liquor License Ordinance/Fees – Attorney Sondalle will work on the Liquor License Ordinance and will present at the June meeting. Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to change the liquor license fees to the following Class "A" -\$25.00, Class "B" Beer - \$100, "Class B" Liquor - \$350.00, Cigarette/Tobacco License - \$25.00 and Publishing fee \$30.00. Motion carried.

Fire dept equipment – Moderow and Berndt will report to the fire department to pick one or the other truck for budget reasons.

Treasurer's Supplies – printer- Moderow/Berndt made a motion for Treasure Machkovich to purchase a printer. Motion carried.

Audience Participation - Josh Goldberg asked about internet near Lakeview Road. The town will be looking into some more options for grants in regard to broadband options.
