

Town of Green Lake
Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, May 8, 2023

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present. There were 8 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Berndt/Moderow to approve the minutes from the regular monthly meeting on Monday, April 10, 2023. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Machkovich's report was reviewed. April credits were \$41,783.86 and debits were \$38,805.04. A motion was made by Berndt/Moderow to accept the report. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – They started shouldering the roads – a lot more to do. Made a parking area down by Horner's. We started mowing cemeteries this week. Also ordered a new flag for Phelps Cemetery. Worked on filling pot holes, grinded tree stumps at Phelps, put up some night arrow on Lakeview Road, Phelps driveway holes need to be patched and maybe need to be redone. The new mower will be here between June 23- July 8th – he ordered parts for the "old" mower until the new one arrives.

2023 Road – Chairman Moderow opened the 1 bid they received for Lakeview Road from Northeast Asphalt. The bid was for \$205,213.00. Scotts Construction will be doing the sealcoating. Chairman Moderow noted that the town held a bit back from last year knowing we were doing the major project on Blackbird Point and not knowing what the cost would be. A motion made by Strelow/Moderow to do Blackbird Point at \$192,270.50, Park Road for \$16,000, Sealcoat Park Road, Kearly's Landing, Twin Lakes, Sandstone totaling \$67,216.74 and wait on Thomas Road. A total of \$480,700.24. Motion carried.

Little Green Lake – Boat Landings, Parking Lot and enforcement was discussed. Dan will call Scott at the county about boat landing permits boxes. Lindsey and Katie will hold onto the current application until the board can decide how they would like to go further.

Green Lake Chamber – Lisa Meier was unable to attend and will come to our June meeting.

City of Markesan Brush Pile – A motion was made to Moderow/Berndt to pay City of Markesan the \$2,493.75 for the chipper fee. Motion carried.

Robert P. Kolton Trust Rezone- Mr. Kolton spoke on his rezone. A motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to approve the rezone. Motion carried.
