

Town of Green Lake - Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, May 11, 2026

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present. There were no citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Moderow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

The motion was made by Strelow, seconded by Berndt to approve the minutes of the regular monthly meeting on April 13, 2026. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt, seconded by Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – the board members reviewed the report. There were \$50,975.35, in credits and \$37,480.51 debits. Reported balances on Money Market, CD and Phelps Savings Account. Motion to approve Treasurer's report and the transfer of \$148,860.49 to the general for the payment of bills. Motion made by Moderow, seconded by Berndt. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – was reported the storm brush has all been cleaned up and any large logs that were cut this winter. The cemeteries have been cleaned up and mowing has started. The wings have been removed from the truck as well as the salters. The 18 truck will get the shoulder machine mounted in the next couple of weeks. The ditch was cleaned out on a small portion of Spring Grove Road (about 100'). Horner's pier wash hit by a crew installing the neighbors boat lift. Dan Berndt knows the company and was told they would fix it. The pier is still usable. Went to look out Twin Lake dam, but it was under water. I called around on cemetery plots and couldn't really pin down a price unless I was planning on buying. The range received in Oshkosh was \$1000-\$4000- which seems pretty steep.

Bulk Trash Day – Will be on Saturday, June 13, 2026 from 7:00 AM until 12:00 PM. Motion made by Moderow/Berndt. Motion carried. Clerk Mehn will put the ad in the newspaper, also at the town hall, and website.

Resolution 2026-01 - Relating to the Refund of certain Overpayments to the Town – A motion made by Strelow/Moderow to approve the Resolution. Motion carried.

Discussion on cemetery software – The town board reviewed the software and will pass at this time.

Cemetery lot pricing – The board will think about it and discuss at the June meeting.

Town hall architect – Chairman Moderow and Supervisor Strelow met with the architect and the town will hire him to do some drawings. His estimate is \$3000 to \$6000. Motion made by Moderow/Strelow to accept his bid.

2026 Road bids – Bids will be ready at the June meeting.

Manure haulers – Rosendale Dairy was on Miller Road, Horner Road, Prairie Road, and Thomas Road. Chairman Moderow would like to get a hold of Sondalle to get a bond for protecting our roads.

White Circle Road – Chairman Moderow had been contacted by the property owner at the end of White Circle. The board made a motion to get a quote from Area Asphalt and we will split it with the property owner 50/50. Motion made by Berndt/Strelow to adjourn at 7:27 PM
