

**Town of Green Lake
2022 Budget Hearing & Electors Meeting & Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, November 8, 2021**

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and in three public places in the Town.

The 2022 budget hearing was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairman Moderow. All members were present. No electors from the Town were present. The 2022 budget summary was available for viewing. Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the budget for 2022 as follows:

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. All board members were present.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the agenda with the addition of Center Road Update by Supervisor Zick. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the minutes from the October 5, 2021, regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Machkovich reported that we received our quarterly payment of \$34,610.76 from the DOT. We did have \$39,629.91 in credits this month. Our total debits were \$17,705.25. There will need to be a transfer out of Phelps of \$607.15 for wages/expenses. Motion was made by Moderow/Zick. Motion carried. She also reported that she will be attending the County's meeting for tax collections later this month.

Maintenance Report – Chairman Moderow reported that were unloading the paver tonight on Center Road and will start working on Little Green Lake road construction this week.

New Business

WiFi Booster – LGLPD would like to have a wireless bridge between the Town's garage to the Town Hall to allow for Wifi connection. LGLPD would be doing the installation and would split the cost 50/50. The total estimate is approximately \$1,500.00. After discussion, a motion was made by Moderow/Zick. Motion carried.

2023 LRIP – Chairman Moderow reported on the two road that the town could use the LRIP funds for. Blackbird Point Road and Sandstone Road are the two roads that were discussed at the meeting.

Boat Launch – Treasurer Machkovich reported that there was a total of \$2,519.99 in boat launching donation on Little Green Lake from May 2021 until October 2021. Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt the 50/50 split with Little Green Lake Protection & Rehabilitation District of \$1,260.00 Motion carried.

Center Road Update: Supervisor Zick commented on the cracks in the new black top. For next year the town will have a deadline in the bids sheet when the work should be completed. Clerk will hold payment until the board approves the road being fixed.
