

UNAPPROVED - Town of Green Lake Town Board Meeting, October 5, 2021

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall, Center House, Walkers, and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present with four citizens.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the minutes from the September 13, 2021, regular monthly meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Zick to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Machkovich reported 17,160.04 in total credits and \$35,136.85 in total debits for the month. \$64.21 to order new deposit slips. Transfer \$1,055.36 out of Phelps into the General account to pay for wages/expense. Motion made by Berndt/Moderow approved the transfer and report. Motion carried.

Maintenance Report – Mowing a lot and road mowing the 2nd time around should be done soon. Center Road construction will hopefully start the end of October. Repair on Oakwood Beach Road storm drainage. Put the town's name on the two lists to rent a brush mower.

Old Business:

Part-Time Highway Employee – Ben called Steve on Tuesday after the meeting – response back. Ben put an ad in the paper and will look into putting it on Indeed also. Ben will touch base once he hears something.

City of Markesan – Recycling Center – no update. Getting an estimate from the Town of Ripon who they used and wait for Kinas estimate. No action taken.

New Business:

Tom Kloosterboer – Oakwood Avenue – Fiberoptic cable has been put in along Oakwood Avenue that runs to two different property owners. There are more people that would like to have faster internet access in the Town. Chairman Moderow stated that the Town was not aware that this was done, and he will look into this. Tom suggested to the town to look into this in a legal perspective. No action taken.

Robert Strelow Land Donation – on the corner of Melmar and Welk Road the size of the land donation is 28 ft. by 173 ft. Mr. Strelow would like this to be made into more parking. Robert has talked with Matt Kirkman at Green Lake County Zoning and has received approval. Chairman Moderow mentioned that he will contact the DNR and look into grants for this project. Moderow will also talk with Zoning, Little Green Lake District and Robert to let them know.

Adopt Redistricting Plan – Motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to adopt the redistricting plan. Motion carried.

Update on the American Rescue Plan Act grant funds – Clerk Mehn mentioned that the town needs to file a report to the US Treasury on what the Town used for funds were used or if no funds were used by October 31, 2021, but recently that has been changed to April 30, 2022. Town is still looking into where to use these funds.

Budget workshop – LRIP Revenue amount will need to be in this year’s budget. They increased the GRFD amount. The rest of the funds will get split into Capital Outlay and Road Construction.

Audience Participation –

Karl Bertram – Wondered how about the gravel on Oakwood Avenue could be cleaned up. Also questioned when County Road N was going to be replaced.

Scott Mundro – thanked the town for their donation to the Green Lake Animal Shelter and also talked about the survey on the broadband issue.
