Regular Town Board Meeting
Monday, October 2, 2023

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

Chairman Moderow called the regular town meeting to order at 7:00 PM. All board members were present. There were 7 citizens in attendance.

The motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

GLSD Sewer Project – Lisa Reas was here to give an update on the sewer project. No action taken.

The motion was made by Moderow/Berndt to approve the minutes from the regular monthly meeting on September 11, 2023. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Berndt/Strelow to approve the vouchers/bills. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Machkovich's report was reviewed. Motion was made by Strelow/Berndt to approve Treasurer's report.

Maintenance Report – He has been working on the truck and pave loader. Getting truck ready for winter. Piers will get removed at the end of the month. He is going to paint at the landings. He will also be sweeping the roads. Also thinking about getting floating piers at Horner's.

Zoning Map Amendment – Matt Kirkman from Green Lake County Zoning came and talked about some parcels that need to be updated. The town has about 30 or so parcels that may want to rezone their properties.

Approval Liquor License and Operators Licenses – Motion made by Moderow/Strelow to approve the updated liquor license for Beuthin's Walker Bar and Grill and two liquor licenses for Patricia Beuthin and Christopher Beuthin – as long as Clerk Mehn receives all paperwork from the new owners. Motion carried.

Road Construction Project 2024 – Dan K. had a list for chip-sealing Menominee, Lakewood, Spring Lake, Eric Road and dead end by Eric Road and for paving Horners Road.

Room Tax – We are still waiting for our ordinance from Attorney Sondalle. No action taken.

Right of Way Operating Permit – We are still waiting for our ordinance from Attorney Sondalle. No action taken.

Fire truck loan – Chairman Moderow talked with Horicon Bank about a loan for 3-5 years at 5.25% for \$420,000. A motion was made to get a loan from Horicon Bank. The three signers should be the three board members. The motion was made by Strelow/Berndt. Motion carried.

November meeting date – November meeting date will be changed to the first Monday of the month, which would be November 6th at 6:45 start time – for budget and tax purposes.

Budget workshop – Board members just looked at the budget worksheets.
