Regular Board Meeting Minutes  
September 12, 2022

Notice for this meeting was given by posting at the Town Hall and the Town's website.

**Treasurer's Report** – Total credits collected in August were \$187,661.21. We did move the ARPA Grants funds into a Grant sub account. Also moved the August Settlement to the sub tax account. We will need to do a transfer for the Egbert invoice for the culverts \$49,355.00. Motion made by Berndt/Moderow. Motion carried.

**Maintenance Report** – No report. He must drill holes in the 4X4 posts for them to brake away.

**Room Tax Ordinance** – After discussion the board will work with Attorney Sondalle on this.

**Noise Ordinance** – After discussion Chairman Moderow will be meeting with GL Sanitary District, City of Green Lake, and Town of Brooklyn about the noise ordinances. Tom Kloosterboer – spoke about the county meetings he has attended. The Land Use Zoning board suggested the town issue a letter to the Land Use Zoning board. Wally Szkwarko- spoke about the noise issue as well. Ken Bates – spoke about trying to do something at the county level.

Motion made by Moderow/Berndt to approve the noise ordinance with changes to Page 1 (b) with public street change and also add who will pay the penalty. Clerk Mehn will talk with Sondalle on these changes.

**Boat Launch Pass Application** – This application will go out with the tax letter/bill in December. Treasurer Machkovich will be collecting and handing out the stickers. Motion made by Berndt/Moderow. Motion carried.
